Subject: Stamping of Hard Edible Medical Cannabis Products

Relevant authority: KRS 218B.095(2)(b)2; 915 KAR 1:040, Section 8(3)

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Kentucky Office of Medical Cannabis

The purpose of this technical advisory is to provide licensees with guidance on the Office of Medical Cannabis's (OMC) interpretation of the requirements for stamping "hard edible" medical cannabis products, and how a licensee may continue to maintain compliance with KRS Chapter 218B and 915 KAR Chapter 1.

The language of KRS 218B.095(2)(b)2 provides that a licensed cannabis business shall not "[a]cquire, possess, cultivate, process, manufacture, deliver, transfer, transport, supply, dispense, or sell: ... [m]edicinal cannabis products intended for oral consumption as an edible, oil, or tincture with more than ten (10) milligrams of delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol per serving."

OMC regulations require hard edible products to be stamped with a standard symbol. Per 915 KAR 1:040, Section 8(3), "[u]nless specifically authorized in writing by the cabinet, all hard medicinal cannabis products intended for oral consumption as an edible shall be stamped with the standardized symbol indicating a product contains medicinal cannabis provided in Appendix A to 915 KAR 1:100." The regulation further provides "[i]f the medicinal cannabis product intended for oral consumption as an edible contains multiple servings, the processor shall ensure a cardholder can easily separate out a single serving from the whole." See 915 KAR 1:040, Section 8(3).

Neither Kentucky law nor OMC regulations prohibit hard edible medical cannabis products. Nor do they prohibit a hard edible medical cannabis product from containing multiple servings. **However**, licensees who create any hard medical cannabis products that contain multiple servings **must** score such products so that a cardholder can easily separate out a single serving from the whole (for example, a 50-milligram gummy that can be easily separated into five 10-milligram servings). In such cases, the standardized symbol indicating a product contains medical cannabis is not required to be stamped on each individual serving, but the licensee must stamp the standardized symbol clearly and visibly across the surface of each hard edible medical cannabis product containing multiple servings, as shown in the example below:
