

**CASEY COUNTY
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 24-000 5**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF
CANNABIS BUSINESS OPERATIONS IN THE COUNTY OF CASEY,
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY**

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2024, the Kentucky General Assembly adopted House Bill 829, signed into law by the Governor on April 17, 2024 amending KRS Chapter 218B, the Kentucky Medical Cannabis Chapter;

WHEREAS, KRS §§218B.090 and 218B.130 authorize local governments to prohibit cannabis business operations within their territory through the passage of an ordinance;

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate, and in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the County of Casey's residents and members of the public who visit, travel, or conduct business in the County of Casey to prohibit all cannabis business within the boundaries of the County of Casey; and

WHEREAS, the County of Casey wishes to utilize the authority granted to it by KRS §§218B.090 and 218B.130 to prohibit cannabis business operations within the boundaries of the County of Casey,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF CASEY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1. Definitions:

The definitions within KRS §218B.010 are hereby adopted as if set out herein and as relevant to this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Cannabis Businesses Prohibited:

All cannabis businesses are hereby prohibited from operating within the boundaries of Casey County.

SECTION 3. Effective date:

This Ordinance shall be effective upon its enactment and publication by the County of Casey.

SECTION 4. The entire Fiscal Court being present, on motion of Bart Woodrum seconded by Cecil Roy, 5 voting in favor, 0 voting against, 0 abstaining, this Ordinance was given first reading and passed on May 1, _____, 2024.

SECTION 5. The entire Fiscal Court being present, on motion of Robby Murphy seconded by Bart Woodrum, 5 voting in favor, 0 voting against, 0 abstaining, this Ordinance was given second reading and passed on June, 19, 2024.
