

**RESOLUTION NO. 24-02  
CITY OF CADIZ, KENTUCKY**

**MEDICAL CANNABIS**

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THAT THE QUESTION OF PROHIBITING CANNABIS BUSINESSES FROM OPERATING WITHIN THE CITY OF CADIZ, KENTUCKY BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF CADIZ, KENTUCKY AT THE NEXT REGULAR ELECTION.

**WHEREAS**, the Kentucky General Assembly in its 2023 regular session approved SB 47 regarding medical cannabis; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 47 authorizes a city to enact ordinances regulating the time, place, and manner of cannabis business operations; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 47 authorizes a city to prohibit all cannabis business operations within its territory; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 47 authorizes a city to enact resolutions directing that the question of prohibiting cannabis businesses from operating within its territory be submitted to the voters of its territory at the next regular election,

**NOW THEREFORE** be it resolved by the city council of the City of Cadiz, Kentucky as follows:

That the city council of the City of Cadiz, Kentucky hereby directs that the question of prohibiting cannabis businesses from operating within its territory be submitted to the voters of its territory at the next regular election.

This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its approval by the city council of the City of Cadiz, Kentucky.
