

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-10-22

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF CANNABIS
BUSINESS OPERATIONS IN THE COUNTY OF ADAIR**

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2024, the Kentucky General Assembly adopted House Bill 829, signed into law by the Governor on April 17, 2024 amending KRS Chp. 218B, the Kentucky Medical Cannabis chapter; and

WHEREAS, KRS §§218B.090 and 218B.130 authorize local governments to prohibit cannabis business operations within their territory through the passage of an ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate, and in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the County of Adair 's residents and members of the public who visit, travel, or conduct business in the County of Adair to prohibit all cannabis business within the boundaries of the County of Adair ; and

WHEREAS, the County of Adair wishes to utilize the authority granted to it by KRS §§218B.090 and 218B.130 to prohibit cannabis business operations with the County of Adair.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of County of Adair, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section 1

Definitions

The definitions within KRS §218B.010 are hereby adopted as if set out herein and as relevant to this ordinance.

Section 2


Cannabis Businesses Prohibited

All cannabis businesses are hereby prohibited from operating within Adair County limits.

Section 3


Effective Date
