# CITY OF CALIFORNIA CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. O-2024-10

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF CANNABIS BUSINESS OPERATIONS IN THE CITY OF CALIFORNIA, KENTUCKY.

**WHEREAS**, on April 15, 2024, the Kentucky General Assembly passed 2024 House Bill 829, signed into law by Governor Andy Beshear on April 17, 2024, that amends KRS Chapter 218B, which codifies the statutes governing the Kentucky Medical Cannabis Program;

**WHEREAS**, KRS 218B.090 and 218B.130 authorize local governments to prohibit cannabis business operations within their territory through the passage of an ordinance;

**WHEREAS**, the City of California wishes to utilize the authority granted to it by KRS 218B.090 and 218B.130 to prohibit cannabis business operations within the city limits of California, Kentucky;

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

### **SECTION 1**

#### **Definitions**

The definitions within KRS 218B.010 are hereby adopted as if set out herein and as relevant to this ordinance.

# **SECTION 2**

## **Cannabis Businesses Prohibited**

All cannabis businesses are hereby prohibited from operating within California city limits.

### **SECTION 3**

## **Effective Date**

That the City Clerk shall attest to the adoption of this Ordinance, and cause the same to be published as required by law; and this Ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately after the date of final passage and approval. This ordinance presented for the first reading on the 16th day of September, 2024. This ordinance passed and adopted at the second reading on the 24th day of September, 2024.
