

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF CANNABIS BUSINESS OPERATIONS IN THE CITY OF CLINTON.**

**WHEREAS**, on April 15, 2024, the Kentucky General Assembly passed 2024 House Bill 829, signed into law by Governor Andy Beshears on April 17, 2024, that amends KRS Chapter 218B, which codifies the statutes governing the Kentucky Medical Cannabis Program;

**WHEREAS**, KRS 218B.090 and 218B.130 authorize local governments to prohibit cannabis business operations within their territory through the passage of an ordinance;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Clinton, wishes to utilize the authority granted to it by KRS 218B.090 and 218B.130 to prohibit cannabis business operations within the City of Clinton;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDANIED by the City of Clinton.**

**Section 1**

**Definitions**

The definitions within KRS 218B.010 are hereby adopted as if set out here in and as relevant to this ordinance.

**Section 2**

**Cannabis Business Prohibited**

All cannabis business are hereby prohibited from operating within the City of Clinton.

**Section 3**

**Effective Date**

This ordinance shall be effective upon its enactment and publication by the City of Clinton.
