

**ORDINANCE NO 06-2024
CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF CANNABIS BUSINESS
OPERATIONS IN THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS, KENTUCKY**

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2024, the Kentucky General Assembly adopted House Bill 829, signed into law by the Governor on April 17, 2024 amending KRS Chp. 218B, the Kentucky Medical Cannabis chapter; and

WHEREAS, KRS §§218B.090 and 218B.130 authorize local governments to prohibit cannabis business operations within their territory through the passage of an ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate, and in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky's residents and members of the public who visit, travel, or conduct business in the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky to prohibit all cannabis business within the boundaries of the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky wishes to utilize the authority granted to it by KRS §§218B.090 and 218B.130 to prohibit cannabis business operations with the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GRAND RIVERS,
KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1: Definitions: The definitions within KRS §218B.010 are hereby adopted as if set out herein and as relevant to this ordinance.

SECTION 2: Cannabis Businesses Prohibited: All cannabis businesses are hereby prohibited from operating within the City of Grand Rivers, Kentucky city limits.

SECTION 3: Enactment and Effective Date: All ordinances, orders, resolutions, motions or parts thereof insofar as some may be in conflict herewith are repealed.

This ordinance shall be published and take effect thereafter.


