A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE QUESTION OF PROHIBITING CANNABIS BUSINESSES FROM OPERATION WITHIN THE LONDON CITY LIMITS

BE SUBMITTED TO VOTERS OF CITY OF LONDON, KENTUCKY

This Resolution is made pursuant to KRS 218B.130, which allows a city such as London, Kentucky to enact a resolution directing the question of prohibiting cannabis businesses from operating within its territory to be submitted to the voters of its territory at the next regular election.

Whereas, the City of London registered voters have the opportunity to determine by vote whether cannabis businesses may operate within the jurisdictional limits of the City of London, and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of London has determined that the voters of the City of London should determine this issue by vote,

Be it therefore Resolved that pursuant to KRS 218B.130, the City Council of the City of London directs the Laurel County Court Clerk place before the eligible voters of the City of London at the next regular election, the question of allowing cannabis businesses to operate within the city limits of the City of London, Kentucky.
