

**CITY OF LYNDON
ORDINANCE # 8-26-24**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CHANGES TO
THE TEXT OF THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE**

WHEREAS, the Louisville Metro Planning Commission has transmitted to the City of Lyndon certain proposed amendments to the Land Development Code, CASE NUMBER 24-LDC-0007 concerning Medical Cannabis and the City desires to allow medical cannabis in the City of Lyndon pursuant to Senate Bill 47,

AND WHEREAS, the City of Lyndon, after consideration of the Findings of Fact and recommendation of the Louisville Metro Planning and Design Services, hereby approves the recommendation of the Planning Commission, with certain modifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDON

Section 1. After review and consideration of the Findings of Fact, and favorable recommendation of the Louisville Metro Planning and Design Services in CASE NUMBER 24-LDC-0007, the City of Lyndon Council hereby approves the recommended Land Development Code amendment, with the following modifications:

- (1) There shall be no additional separation distance requirements other than what is in Kentucky Revised Statutes. Therefore, Sections 4.2.67 (B) and 4.3.30 (B) in CASE NUMBER 24-LDC-0007 are not approved and shall not apply in the City of Lyndon.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval as required by law.

Introduction and First Reading: August 26, 2024

Second Reading and Passage: September 23, 2024
