ORDINANCE NO. 388

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF CANNABIS BUSINESS OPERATIONS IN THE CITY OF MULDRAUGH, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, on April 15. 2024, the Kentucky General Assembly passed 2024 House Bill 829, signed into law by Governor Andy Beshear on April 17, 2024, that amends KRS Chapter 218B, which codifies the statutes governing the Kentucky Cannabis Program:

WHEREAS, KRS 218B.090 and 218B.130 authorize local governments to prohibit cannabis business operations within their territory through the passage of an ordinance;

WHEREAS, the City of Muldraugh wishes to utilize the authority granted to it by KRS 218B.090 and 218B.130 to prohibit cannabis business operations within the City of Muldraugh, Kentucky;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Muldraugh, Kentucky:

SECTION 1

Definitions

The definitions with KRS 218B.010 are hereby adopted as if set out herein and as relevant to this ordinance.

SECTION 2

Cannabis Business Prohibited

All cannabis businesses are hereby prohibited from operating within the City of Muldraugh limits.

SECTION 3

Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective upon its enactment and publication as required by the law.

This ordinance read for the first time on August 12, 2024 and having been read for the second time September 9, 2024and if passed shall become effective after the publication as required by statue.
