

ORDINANCE NO. 03-2025

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF CANNABIS BUSINESS
OPERATIONS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO**

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2024, the Kentucky General Assembly passed 2024 House Bill 829, signed into law by Governor Andy Beshear on April 17, 2024, that amends KRS Chapter 218B, which codifies the statutes governing the Kentucky Medicinal Cannabis Program;

WHEREAS, KRS 218B.090 and 218B.130 authorizes local governments to prohibit cannabis business operations within their territory through the passage of an ordinance;

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento wishes to utilize the authority granted to it by KRS 218B.090 and 218B.130 to prohibit cannabis business operations within Sacramento;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Sacramento, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section 1

Definitions

The definitions within KRS 218B.010 are hereby adopted as if set out herein and as relevant to this ordinance.

Section 2

Cannabis Business Prohibited


All cannabis businesses are hereby prohibited from operating within Sacramento City limits.


Section 3

Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective upon its enactment and publication by the McLean County News.

The foregoing Ordinance was introduced and read for the first time on the 17th day of March, 2025 at a Regular City Commission meeting, and read for the second time on the 21st day of April, 2025 at a Regular City Commissioner meeting with passage by a roll call vote of 3 yeas and 0 nays.
