## CITY OF SEBREE, KENTUCKY RESOLUTION 2024-003

# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A REFERENDUM TO DETERMINE WHETHER CANNABIS BUSINESS OPERATIONS MAY OCCUR IN THE CITY OF SEBREE

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2024, the Kentucky General Assembly passed 2024 House Bill 829, which was subsequently signed into law by Governor Andy Beshear on April 17, 2024, that amends KRS Chapter 218B, which codifies the statutes governing the Kentucky Medical Cannabis Program;

WHEREAS, KRS 218B.130 authorizes local governments to pass resolutions directing that the question of prohibiting cannabis businesses from operating within its territory be submitted to the voters of its territory at the next regular election;

WHEREAS, the City of Sebree wishes to utilize the authority granted to it by KRS 218B.130 to direct that the question of prohibiting cannabis businesses from operating within the City of Sebree be submitted to the voters of the City of Sebree at the next regular election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Sebree:

### Section 1 Definitions

The definitions within KRS 218B.010 are hereby adopted as it set out herein and as relevant to this resolution.

#### Section 2

### Cannabis Business Referendum Authorized

Pursuant to KRS 218B.130(2)(a)(2) and KRS 218B.130(3)(b), the City of Sebree hereby resolves that the question of prohibiting cannabis businesses from operating within the City of Sebree be submitted to the voters of the City of Sebree at the next regular general election in accordance with the language of KRS 218B.130(3)(b).

The ballot for the 2024 election shall state as follows: "Are you in favor of the sale of medicinal cannabis at a licensed dispensary and the operation of other cannabis businesses in Sebree, Kentucky? Yes or No?"

### Section 3 Effective Date

The resolution shall be effective upon its enactment and publication by the City of Sebree.
