#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2024-001**

# AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PROHIBITION OF CANNABIS BUSINESS OPERATIONS IN THE COUNTY OF <u>HARLAN</u>

WHEREAS, On April 15, 2024, the Kentucky General Assembly adopted House Bill 829, signed into law by the Governor on April 17, 2024 amending KRS Chp. 218B, the Kentucky Medical Cannabis chapter; and

**WHEREAS,** KRS 218B.090 and 218B.130 authorize local governments to prohibit cannabis business operations within their territory through the passage of an ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate, and in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the County of <u>Harlan's</u> residents and members of the public who visit, travel, or conduct business in the County of <u>Harlan</u> to prohibit all cannabis within the boundaries of the County of Harlan; and

**WHEREAS,** the County of <u>Harlan</u> wishes to utilize the authority granted to it by KRS 218B.090 and 218B.130 to prohibit cannabis business operations with the County of <u>Harlan</u>.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the fiscal court of county of Harlan, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

#### Section 1

### **Definitions**

The definitions within KRS 218B.010 are hereby adopted as if set out herein and as relevant to this ordinance

#### Section 2

#### **Cannabis Businesses Prohibited**

All cannabis businesses are hereby prohibited from operating with Harlan County limits.

## Section 3

## **Effective Date**

This ordinance shall be effective upon its enactment and publication by the County of Harlan.
