

Transporting Medical Cannabis Products

Registered cardholders are allowed to possess and transport the **standard supply** of medical cannabis in raw plant material or product format equivalency provided below:

Supply/Product	Raw Plant Material	Concentrates	THC-Infused	Non-Consumable (Topical)
30-day supply*	112 grams (4 ounces)	28 grams	3,900 milligrams	N/A
10-day supply	37.5 grams	9.5 grams	1,300 milligrams	N/A

*An authorized medical cannabis practitioner may increase or decrease the supply limit per product format in a qualified patient's written certification.

Registry ID cardholder type	Transport from dispensary to cardholder's residence (if contained in an unopened package)	Carry on person (excluding transportation from dispensary)
In-state qualified patient	30-day supply	10-day supply
Minor qualified patient	<i>Not allowed*</i>	
Designated caregiver	30-day supply (per registered patient)	10-day supply (per registered patient)
Visiting qualified patient	10-day supply	10-day supply

*Minor qualified patients cannot possess medical cannabis and may only use of medical cannabis with the assistance of their designated caregiver(s).



Required activities



▶ Carrying your medical cannabis registry ID card when in possession of medical cannabis products



▶ Keeping medical cannabis in its original container during transport



▶ Maintaining at least a two-step process to access medical cannabis while driving or operating machinery



▶ When requested by law enforcement, providing your medical cannabis card and valid ID



Prohibited activities



▶ Driving or operating machinery under the influence of medical cannabis



▶ Possessing medical cannabis within arm's reach while driving or operating machinery



▶ Possessing or using medical cannabis on school¹ property except as allowed by school policy



▶ Traveling over state lines with your medical cannabis products

¹"School" means a public elementary or secondary school of the state and non-public schools certified by the Kentucky Department of Education.
